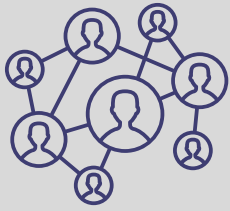

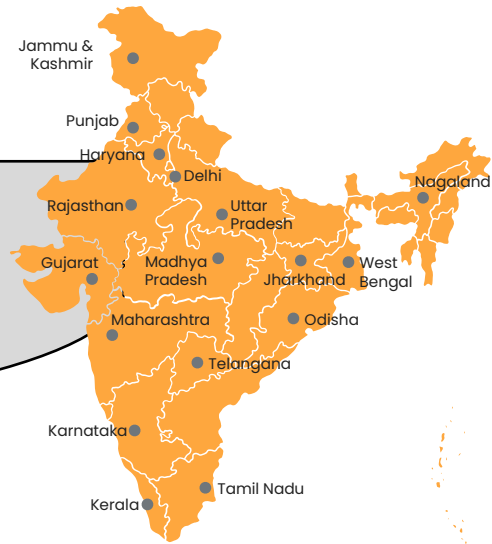
In view of the Association's commendable work, the Government of India issued a Commemorative postal stamp in honor of FPA India's 50th year of existence.
